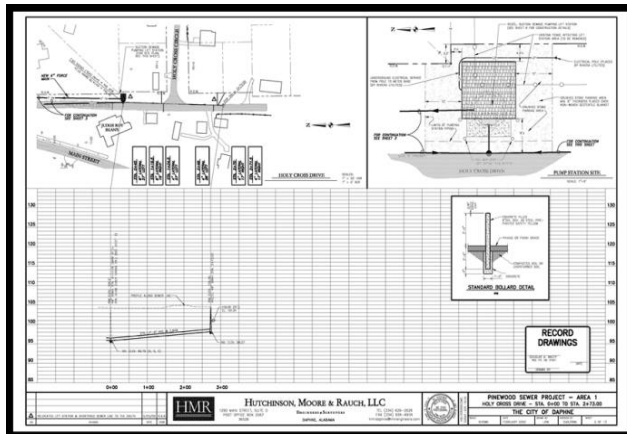




Daphne Utilities Sanitary Sewer Project

Daphne Utilities, formerly known as the Utilities Board of the City of Daphne, contracted Hutchinson, Moore & Rauch, LLC to provide engineering, surveying, permitting, and construction surveillance for a number of sanitary sewer projects in the "Olde Towne Daphne" area. This was a continuing project of constructing sanitary sewer in this unsewered area of this Eastern Shore city. This addressed an environmental issue along the eastern shore of Mobile Bay. The various projects included gravity sewer, force mains, low pressure force mains and sewer pumping stations. The area is mainly residential with a few commercial businesses. It is the oldest part of the city which meant traffic to businesses, schools, churches and homes had to stay open and flowing.
